Present Continuous - Use



We use the Present Continuous to talk about an action that is happening...

NOW

AT THE MOMENT

They **are playing** in the park.



Present Continuous - Form

Affirmative

Subject + **verb to be - Present Simple** + **verb + ing**
(am / is / are)

Complete with the verb *to drink*:

I	am	drinking	(drink + ing)
You	are	drinking	(drink + ing)
He / She / It	is	drinking	(drink + ing)
We	are	drinking	(drink + ing)
You	are	drinking	(drink + ing)
They	are	drinking	(drink + ing)



Present Continuous - Form

Negative

Subject + **verb to be - Present Simple (neg.)** + **verb + ing**

Complete with the verb *to drink*:

I	am not	drinking	(drink + ing)
You	are not (aren't)	drinking	(drink + ing)
He / She / It	is not (isn't)	drinking	(drink + ing)
We	are not (aren't)	drinking	(drink + ing)
You	are not (aren't)	drinking	(drink + ing)
They	are not (aren't)	drinking	(drink + ing)



Present Continuous - Form

Interrogative

Verb to be - Present Simple + subject + verb + ing

Complete with the verb *to drink*:

Am	I	drinking	(drink + ing) ?
Are	you	drinking	(drink + ing) ?
Is	he / she / it	drinking	(drink + ing) ?
Are	we	drinking	(drink + ing) ?
Are	you	drinking	(drink + ing) ?
Are	they	drinking	(drink + ing) ?
